Policy for Ph.D candidates seeking admission to Ph.D program under Industrial sponsored Seats at Bombay College of Pharmacy

1. There are total 35 seats for Ph.D (Tech) program out of which 5 seats are reserved for industry sponsored Ph.D.
2. No Objection Certificate should be provided by the industry mentioning grant of permission from the industry to the candidate for pursuing Ph.D and making available their laboratory for the student to carry out the PhD research project. The industry can have their own guidelines for sanction of the same.
3. Candidates under this category should be GPAT qualified or should have passed the PhD Entrance Test (PET) exam held by the University of Mumbai for the specific branch. GATE too can be considered in certain circumstances.
4. The laboratory/Research center of the industry sponsoring the candidate should be recognized by Department of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR) as a Scientific and Industrial Research Organization (SIRO). If not, it has to be approved by Bombay College of Pharmacy (BCP).
5. A co-guide can be appointed from the industry who will monitor the day-to-day research work being done by the candidate at the industry. Approval of co- guide has to be done by BCP and later by the University of Mumbai. Though BCP is autonomous, PhD studies are still under the purview of University of Mumbai.
6. The Project work will be done by the candidate himself/herself and cannot be assigned to the subordinates.
7. The candidates should complete the mandatory course work as prescribed by the University of Mumbai and should spend at least 180 days, over the whole tenure of PhD program, at BCP.
8. All rules and regulations as prescribed by University of Mumbai and BCP from time to time will be applicable
9. The Ph.D candidate while presenting or publishing his/her work in any journal/National or International conference shall mention affiliation of both the industry and Bombay College of Pharmacy.
10. Fees prescribed by BCP will have to be paid as per the notices issued for fee payment during the complete tenure of the PhD program.
